Holiday Tips

If you are planning to go away for the coming holiday period, we suggest you make sure that you have unplugged your computer, printer, ADSL modem, monitor, and speaker power cables from the wall. This way if we should have any storms while you are away, it will not damage your sensitive equipment.

Also, be sure to unplug the PHONE LINE from the wall to your modem as well, as lightning, even when striking 5 kms away, can send surges down your phone line and damage your modem.

For our satellite broadband customers, we suggest disconnecting the satellite modem from the incoming cables while you are away, as lightning can affect the modem through the satellite dish if the strikes are close.

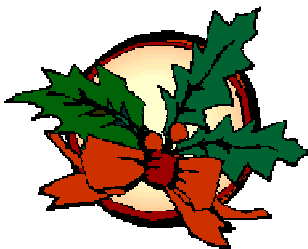
And above all, keep safe over the holiday period.
